- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of Northeastern State University and connect with an NSU academic advisor to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** After semester three coursework, apply for admission at Northeastern State University as a transfer student (<https://apply.nsuok.edu/>).

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- **Transcripts:** Submit official TCC transcript to NSU ([www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts](http://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts)).
- **Reverse Transfer:** If you have not earned an Associate in Arts or an Associate in Science from TCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at TCC, email [reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu](mailto:reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu) to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program.
- **Schedule to take your first education certification test, the OGET (Oklahoma General Education Test)** [www.ceoe.nesinc.com](http://www.ceoe.nesinc.com)

## NSU Program Information:

Admission to the teacher education program at NSU requires the following:

- 45 credit hours and a minimum **2.75 GPA**
- All courses completed with a "C" or better grade and an average 2.5 GPA
- Pass the **OGET (Oklahoma General Education Test)** (end of semester 5). OGET can be waived with an ACT composite score of 22+ with writing component.

In addition to the OGET required for admission, students are required to complete the following certification tests throughout the program:

- **OSAT (Oklahoma Subject Area Test)** - must be attempted prior to full internship (semester 8)
- **PPAT (Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers)** - embedded into semester 7 and 8

## TULSA COMMUNITY COLLEGE - PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Northeastern State University (NSU) and Tulsa Community College (TCC) accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, mutually enter into this articulation agreement to provide students with the educational opportunity to complete an Associate in Science in Child Development at Tulsa Community College which will serve as the first two years of a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education degree at the Northeastern State University. In accordance with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy 3.11, this agreement will be subject to the following provisions:

1. The student shall have graduated from Tulsa Community College (TCC) with an Associate in Science in Child Development degree with a total of 60 credit hours (excluding zero-level classes and physical education activity courses).
2. The student shall earn 68 credit hours at NSU, excluding physical education activity courses, of which 40 semester hours must be in 3000/4000 level courses.
3. The courses in the Associate in Science in Child Development degree at Tulsa Community College outlined in the following pages will be accepted as satisfying the general education and computer proficiency requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education at NSU.
4. Provided the student follows the sequence of both the associate degree program and the baccalaureate degree program, the student will be able to complete the baccalaureate degree program in 128 credit hours, the same hours required for a native student.
  - **NOTE:** *This agreement is 4 credit hours above the required 124 credit hours for graduation at NSU. This agreement meets the requirements for both the A.S. and B.S. degrees in full.*
5. The student shall have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (an average grade of “C” or better) at Tulsa Community College.
6. TCC and NSU will cooperatively develop course-to-course equivalencies, transfer guides, and degree plans necessary for each student to progress from the associate degree through the baccalaureate degree.
7. Each institution is committed to providing a seamless education path for the students in Associate in Science in Child Development program and to enhancing this partnership.
8. Each institution will consult the other institution when considering curriculum changes which will impact this articulation agreement.

The student shall submit an application for admission to both institutions. The student must submit an official copy of their Tulsa Community College transcript to NSU once TCC courses have been completed. The NSU office of admissions will formally notify the student of his/her admission status to NSU.

Upon formal approval of this articulation agreement by the appropriate officials of the two institutions, each is free to publicize the terms herein. This agreement shall remain in effect until one or all of the institutions deem it necessary to modify or terminate the agreement.
