### **TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:**

- **Faculty Advisement:** Meet with a Human Services faculty member early in your academic career and each semester to address your career interests and plan your degree path.
- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of Northeastern State University and connect with a NSU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at Northeastern State University as a transfer student (<https://apply.nsuok.edu/>).
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation>.
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to NSU ([www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts](http://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts)).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email [reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu](mailto:reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu) to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).

### **Program Information and Recommended Actions - NSU:**

- Students will need to submit their application to the BSW practicum after completing all general education requirements as well as the following courses:
  - SOC 1113 Introduction to Sociology
  - PSYC 1113 Introduction to Psychology
  - College Math: MATH 1313 Elementary Statistics (MATH 2193 Elementary Statistics) or MATH 1513 College Algebra or MATH 1473 Applied Mathematics (Quantitative Reasoning)/ or MATH 1523 Functions & Change
  - COMM 1113 Fundamentals of Oral Communication. (Public Speaking)
  - BIOL 1114 Biology with Lab
  - SOC 3323 Social Statistics (PSYC 2223/SOCI 2223 – Behavioral Statistics)
- Also, applicants must be enrolled or have completed the following courses at that time of practicum application submission. Students must have completed 88 hours prior to beginning Practicum.
  - SOWK 2013 Introduction to Social Work (HSVC 1113 Principles of Human Services)
  - SOWK 4003 HBSE I (HSVC 2023 Lifespan Development)
  - SOWK 4613 Human Diversity
  - SOWK 3013 Interviewing Skills
- Applicants must have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale

- The deadline for the Practicum Application is October 31<sup>st</sup> (of the junior year).

### **Baccalaureate Degree Information:**

- Students must complete 60 of 124 credit hours from a university (four-year school), excluding physical education courses.
- 30 credit hours are required from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- At least 18 hours or 50% of the major, whichever is greater, must be from NSU; half the major must be upper level (3000/4000).
- English proficient (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) with a C or better.
- Computer proficient.

- Students must earn a grade of “C” or better in courses to be used for major credit. Grades lower than a “C” in NSU or transfer courses will not apply for major or minor credit.
