TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of Northeastern State University and connect with a NSU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at Northeastern State University as a transfer student (<u>https://apply.nsuok.edu/</u>).
- Final Semester at TCC: Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation with your academic advisor (<u>https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation</u>).
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to NSU (<u>www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts</u>).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer).

Program Information and Recommended Actions - NSU:

- Students must earn a grade of C or better in courses used for major or minor credit. Grades lower than a C from NSU or transfer institutions will not apply for major or minor credit.
- Students in the Spanish B.A. degree program will participate in and complete program assessment procedures. These procedures include, but may not be limited to, periodic evaluations of speaking and writing proficiency and the creation of a portfolio of artifacts from the student's upper-division Spanish courses. Assessment procedures are administered by Spanish faculty without cost to the student.
- This program requires a minor.

Baccalaureate Degree Information:

- Students must complete 60 of 124 credit hours from a university (four-year school), excluding physical education courses.
- 30 credit hours are required from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- At least 18 hours or 50% of the major, whichever is greater, must be from NSU; half the major must be upper level (3000/4000).
- English proficient (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) with a C or better.
- Computer proficient.
