## Accelerated B.S.Ed. Special Education-Mild/Moderate Disorders to M.Ed. Special Education-Autism Spectrum Disorders

### IMPORTANT:

- Students admitted to the Accelerated B.S.Ed. Special Education to M.Ed. Special Education-Autism Spectrum Disorders degree program will complete up to 11 hours of graduate level credit to apply toward both the undergraduate and graduate degrees.
- Students may not receive credit toward the bachelor's degree for both the undergraduate and the paired graduate-level course. A student completing an undergraduate course and the paired graduate-level course will only receive credit for one course toward the bachelor's degree.
- Students must meet all minimum grade and GPA requirements for the undergraduate program.
- A minimum grade of C is required for all 5000 level graduate courses.
- Students who do not follow the approved degree plan may become ineligible to continue in the accelerated degree program.
- Prior to completing the undergraduate degree, if the undergraduate GPA, graduate GPA and/or overall GPA fall below a 3.00, the student becomes ineligible to continue in the ADP.
- Students may withdraw from an approved accelerated degree pathway. Graduate credit hours completed prior to the student withdrawing or becoming ineligible to continue in the ADP apply toward the undergraduate degree only.

- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to NSU ([www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts](http://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts)).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email [reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu](mailto:reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu) to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).

### **Additional Program Information:**

Admission to the teacher education program at NSU requires the following:

- 45 credit hours and a minimum **2.75 GPA**
- All courses completed with a "C" or better grade and an average 2.5 GPA

Students are required to complete the following certification tests throughout the program:

- **OSAT (Oklahoma Subject Area Test)** - must be attempted prior to full internship (semester 8)
- **PPAT (Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers)** - embedded into semester 7 and 8

### **Baccalaureate Degree Information:**

- Students must complete 60 of 124 credit hours from a university (four-year school), excluding physical education courses.
- 30 credit hours are required from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- At least 18 hours or 50% of the major, whichever is greater, must be from NSU; half the major must be upper level (3000/4000).
- English proficient (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) with a C or better.
- Computer proficient.
