- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at NEO can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at NEO:** Consider a campus tour of Northeastern State University and connect with a NSU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your NEO academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at NEO:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at Northeastern State University as a transfer student (<https://apply.nsuok.edu/>).

- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official NEO transcript to NSU @ <https://neo.edu/academics/request-transcripts/>

### **Program Information and Recommended Actions - NSU:**

- Students must complete a minimum of 60 of 120 credit hours from a university (four-year school), excluding physical education courses.
- 30 credit hours are required from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- English proficiency (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) must be met with a grade of C or better in each course respectively.
- Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in courses to be used for major credit. Grades lower than a "C" in NSU or transfer courses will not apply for major or minor credit.
- Computer proficient.
- General electives can be chosen from social work courses as well as courses from other programs.

### **BSW Practicum Application Information:**

- Students will need to submit their application to the BSW practicum after completing all general education requirements as well as the following NEO general education courses (or their NSU equivalent):
  - SOCI 1113 Introduction to Sociology - NEO
  - PSYC 1113 General Psychology - NEO
  - 1493 General College Math or 1513 College Algebra - NEO
  - SPCH 2713 Introduction to Speech Communication - NEO
  - BIOL 1114 Introductory to Biology, populations, Ecosystems - NEO
  - PSYC 2223/SOCI 2223 – Behavioral Statistics - NEO
- Practicum applicants must be enrolled or have completed the following BSW program courses at that time of practicum application submission. Students must have completed 88 total hours prior to beginning Practicum.
  - SOCI 2013 Introduction to Social Work - NEO
  - PSYC 1603 Developmental Psychology - NEO
  - SOWK 4613 Human Diversity - NSU
  - SOWK 3013 Interviewing Skills - NSU
  - SOWK 3101 APA Workshop – NSU
- Applicants must have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale.
