CSC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at CSC can help you fast-track your transfer and keep you on schedule. Reach out to your Student Success Coaches to discuss planning for summer classes.
- **During or After Year One at CSC:** Take a campus tour of Northeastern State University and meet with an NSU academic advisor to make sure you're on track for your transfer.

- **Graduation Requirements:** Students are responsible for adhering to all policies, procedures, and regulations of Connors State College, including meeting all graduation requirements and verifying the accuracy of their degree check. Student Success Coaches and faculty members may not substitute, waive, or exempt students from any established requirement or academic standard. While these advisors make every effort to provide accurate and current information, all advising information regarding coursework, academic progress, and graduation is considered unofficial. The Connors State Registrar's office is the official and final authority for all program, degree, and graduation requirements.
It is strongly recommended that students enroll in a sufficient number of courses to total 30 credit hours each academic year. Students should also obtain a graduation check upon completing 30 credit hours.
- **Minimum Hours for Graduation:** Each degree program has a specific minimum number of semester credit hours required for graduation, as outlined in the college catalog. No student shall be permitted to graduate having completed fewer total hours than the requirement specified for that degree.
- **Grade-Point Average for Graduation:** A retention/graduation grade point average of 2.00 or higher is required for all courses in which a student has a recorded grade, excluding any courses repeated or reprieved and excluding remedial courses and physical education activity courses.
- **During Year Two at CSC:** Apply for admission to Northeastern State University as a transfer student during or immediately after completing your third semester coursework (<https://apply.nsuok.edu/>).
- **Transcripts:** After completing your final semester, submit an official CSC transcript to NSU.

Program Information and Recommended Actions - NSU:

- Teacher Education Admission and Certification Policies
- In addition to courses in the discipline, all students completing a baccalaureate degree that leads to teacher certification must meet the following requirements for certification.
 - Be accepted for admission to teacher education, pre-II internship, and full internship according to published course sequence and guidelines.

- o Demonstrate proficiency at the high novice level in a language other than English.
- o Complete all courses in the major and Professional Education Core with a grade of "C" or higher.
- o Students entering NSU beginning Fall 2013 must have an overall GPA of 2.75 for admission to teacher education.
- o Once admitted to the teacher education program, all majors must continue to maintain a GPA of 2.5 (overall and in their major field of study) through completion.
- o 4 X 12 requirement - Early Childhood, Elementary Education, and Special Education programs require completion of 12 semester hours with a grade of "C" or better in the following disciplines: Communication Arts (English, Communication, Literature), Math, Science, and Social Science (Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology) prior to graduation.
- o All Professional Education majors must complete PSYC 1003 or PSYC 1113. Advisors recommend those courses be completed as part of the General Education course sequence.

Baccalaureate Degree Information:

- Students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours to earn a Bachelor's degree from NSU.
- Students must complete 60 credit hours from a four-year university, excluding physical education courses.
- 30 credit hours must be completed in residence from NSU.
- 40 credit hours must be junior and senior (3000/4000) level courses.
- At least 18 hours or 50% of the major, whichever is greater, must be from NSU; half the major must be upper level (3000/4000).
- English proficient (ENGL 1113 Composition & ENGL 1213 Composition II) with a grade of C or better.
- Computer proficient.
